

# **Clearances Information**

## **Needed Certifications:**

All prospective PACS-affiliated volunteers and interns must obtain the three following certifications in order to be cleared to work with our programs:

- 1. Report of criminal history from the Pennsylvania State Police.
- 2. Child Abuse History certification from the Department of Human Services.
- 3. Fingerprint based federal criminal history (FBI) submitted through the Pennsylvania State Police (some may be exempt from this requirement see details online).
  - Use SERVICE CODE: 1KG6ZJ

#### **Submission of Clearances:**

Prior to the first day of your volunteer/intern experience, a copy of certifications must be submitted to Pitt-Assisted Communities & Schools.
